HISTORY: A shocking decision was made by prosecutors in Nebraska who were unable to prosecute Pamir Safi after the Judge ruled out too much evidence to continue the case. The third trial was slated to begin February 19 against Safi who had been arrested for raping three women. One of these women was Tory Bowen whose case drew national attention after Judge Chevront barred her from using terms including rape, sexual assault, date rape drugs, and sexual assault nurse examiner in her testimony. It is time for an even BIGGER and BOLDER presence to remind the courts that victims have rights too! Tory's case is just the tip of the iceberg when it comes to injustice in the courtrooms that victims face every day. We will not tolerate this type of treatment anymore!
